Governing Board Minutes – April 23, 2015

CALL TO ORDER/ROLL CALL

A public meeting of the Governing Board was called to order by Dr. Eren Ozgen, President, at 12:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Minutes of March 18, 2015 were unanimously approved by the Board.

FACILITY CONTRACT

The Board discussed what action they should take to fix the facility contact with Bay District Schools. During the last Board meeting, Mr. Bozarth stated he remembers that the agreement was that 50% of the rent goes towards purchasing but does not know how that did not get put in the contract. Mr. Husfelt recommended RLA have an attorney talk to Mr. Franklin Harrison, the District attorney. Mr. Steinbrecher, a parent at RLA and attorney, said that he knows Mr. Franklin Harrison personally and can talk to him. Dr. Ozgen informed Mr. Steinbrecher that they need to know how much it would cost up front and have the details of the communications and time spent working to resolve the issue.

FINANCIAL OPTION FINANCING by MS. HOLMES and MRS. JABER

Board Member, Mrs. Chelsea Holmes, presented the financing option from Regency Bank, which would include around 4% interest rate.

Suha Jaber presented a financing option through a charter school financing company, which would provide RLA with 200k and only 4,000 administrative fees, but it must be paid in 4 months. Suha is waiting on another charter school company, Charter School Capital, to provide their financing option.

PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

1. Paychex is now doing payroll, health insurance, Workers' Comp and HR for RLA. By joining the big group of Paychex, the health insurance coverage is more affordable. There is an administrative fee of \$50 per full time employee and \$17.50 for part time.
